(Am I always insistent on my needs and rights?)

Love is not irritable or bitter.

(Am I forgiving? Do I keep a record of wrongs?)

Love delights in truth and righteousness.

(Do I put obedience to God first in my life?)

*(take a moment to confess any sin that the Holy Spirit has brought to mind during this time)*

## WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

## READ—JAMES 1:19-27

### DISCUSSION:

1. Why do you think James singles out these three virtues:  
1) quick to listen, 2) slow to speak, and 3) slow to get angry, when there are many others he could have chosen? how are they related?
2. Of the three skills James talked about in the beginning of this story, which one comes easier for you? Which one is harder? Why do you think so?
3. How can it be that obeying God's law actually sets a person free?
4. How does the Gospel—Jesus in our place and us in his—give us a power to speak and act differently?
5. How has God's Word spoken hope into your life?
6. What might it look like to speak hope into the life of someone you know who is hurting?

### PRAYER

1. Pray specifically that God would reveal his power in our lives to help us to obey his Word. Pray that our spiritual dullness would be replaced with real zeal for Jesus; that we would desire to be changed to be more like him.
2. Pray for our city and its guests; that Christians would show love and hospitality towards each other and that God would use the events of the weekend to bring healing to our city.
